The Malayan pirates, captured by the boats of the *Wolf*, have come to Calcutta in that vessel, for the purpose of being tried. Yesterday the prisoners underwent an examination before the Chief Magistrate; but as some delay took place in procuring an interpreter, the necessary investigation could not be concluded. It will be resumed to-day. We hear that Mr. McFarlan was, after much enquiry, fortunate enough to procure the assistance of the Right Rev. the Bishop of Cochin China, who rendered the evidence in French very much to the satisfaction of the Bench. *Englishman*, Aug. 3.
